Pronounced "Doh-gon," the restaurant serves vibrant cuisine through an Afro-Caribbean lens, drawing from Onwuachi's unique Nigerian, Jamaican, Trinidadian, and Creole background.

Set against a captivating ambiance enriched by a soulful playlist, Dōgon invites guests to indulge in exquisite dishes that celebrate this rich heritage. The restaurant is now open and ready to delight diners with its fresh and imaginative offerings and specially curated cocktails.

Onwuachi, who currently owns Tatiana in New York City, has penned multiple books, like his successful memoir *Notes from a Young Black Chef*, and the bestselling cookbook *My America: Recipes from a Young Black Chef*. He has also been a contestant and a judge on Bravo's Top Chef.

In 2019, he was acclaimed by *Esquire* as its Chef of the Year, recognized by *Food & Wine* as one of its Best New Chefs, and named by the James Beard Foundation as "Rising Star Chef of the Year." Tatiana has been hailed as the city's best restaurant by the *New York Times* and received multiple stellar reviews.



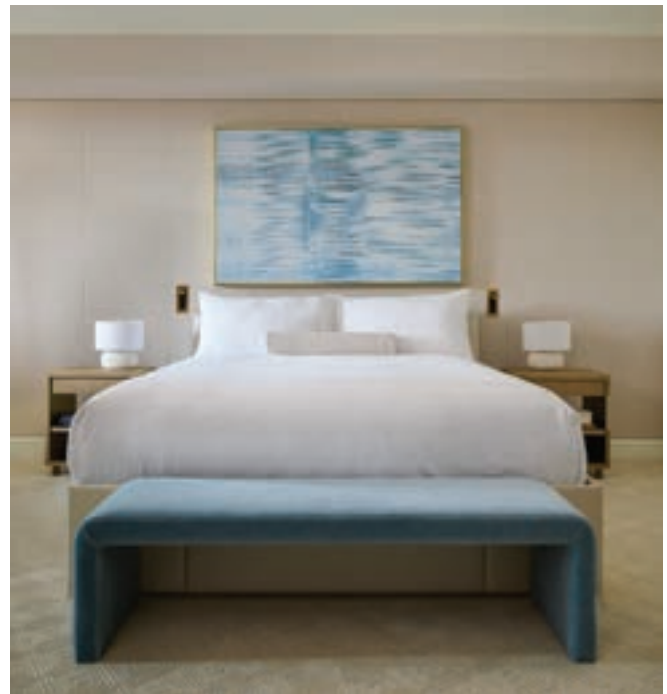
